MARKET BEEF WEIGH-IN—IMPORTANT—ACTION NEEDED BEFORE WEIGH IN

The date for Market Beef weigh in is December 4 from 8 a.m. — 10 a.m.

Since we are using the 840 tag technology we are going to be trying a different procedure at weigh in. We will be asking you to make your fair entry for your market beef at the weigh in. We can scan the tag and enter the weight with your entry (if everything works). Look for more information that day about what you need to do.

DO THIS BEFORE WEIGH IN

1. Complete your 4-H enrollment in 4honline if you are taking your project through 4-H. Be sure to add your market beef project and any other projects you plan to take in 2022. If you need to add other projects before the April 1 enrollment deadline, we will help you do that.
2. Complete the tagging form and bring to weigh in.
