

## 2020 Junior Fair Changes as of 1/22/2020

### **DOG**

- Show Times  
Saturday, August 1 – 10:00 a.m. Showmanship/Obedience will be held in Bruner  
Monday, August 3 – 9:00 a.m. Rally/Agility will be held in Rabbit Show Barn
- Graduate A & B Classes: Renamed to Modified Graduate A and Modified Graduate B  
  
Modified Graduate A (can be entered in A division for two years if needed but not required) Exercises to complete: Heel Free, Figure Eight (off leash), Drop on Recall, Dumbbell Recall, Recall Over High Jump and Stand Stay Get Your Leash  
  
Modified Graduate B - Exercises to complete: Heel Free, Figure Eight (off leash), Drop on Recall, Dumbbell Recall over High Jump, Recall Over Broad Jump, and Stand Stay Get Your Leash

### **EQUINE**

- Change dressage to the following:  
  
Classical Dressage Classes  
HP-1 Introduction Test A  
HP-2 Introduction Test B  
HP-3 Introduction Test C  
HP-4 Training Level Test 1  
HP-5 Percentage Class (May show in any dressage class that is not already offered. Can enter two times with two different tests.)

HP-7 Introduction Test 2  
HP-8 Basic Level Test 1  
HP-9 Basic Level Test 2  
  
All Dressage awards will be presented at lunch break on Tuesday  
Move Dressage to Monday morning. Groom and Clean to follow dressage.
- Eliminate the 10-minute breaks before all championship classes, judge to pass out championship patterns to exhibitors in the arena.
- Trail classes will be on Tuesday, August 4 and Gymkhana classes will be on Wednesday, August 5.
- Western Pleasure will be combined to be: Jr. 8-13 and Sr. 14-18
- Walk Trot Ranch will be with Canter Ranch
- An Obstacle Challenge will be added to Monday night as a fun class

### **GOAT**

- Exotic showmen do not need to wear white

### **POULTRY**

- The market show will begin with broilers
- For 2020, there will be no PPLO blood testing for poultry (chickens and turkeys). This is determined by ODA and may be required again in 2021.

## **BEEF**

- General Rule #2: Change wording to Steers must meet breed standards to show in a breed class. If an exhibitor is showing in a breed class, they must be able to produce proof of breed if called upon. If proof cannot be provided, the animal will be assigned to the crossbred class.
- Remove Rule #8 and #9
- Animals are considered feeder calves up to 900 pounds but must be born after January 1 of present year
- Add a miniature breeds class

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

### ***REMINDER ABOUT FAMILY ANIMALS...***

A family may tag in 1 (one) family animal per species. This animal may be used only in the case where a veterinarian deems one of the exhibitor's other tagged animals not able to show due to a medical reason. Proof from the veterinarian will be required. The animal may be used by exhibitors living in the same household.

### ***QUALITY ASSURANCE...***

There are slight changes to QA for this year. Be sure to look at the information when it is released.

***DUNF COLLECTION*** at the Fair will be from 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. on Friday July 31. Place is TBD depending on location of Junior Fair Board office. Any other required species paperwork will also be collected at this time: swine Paylean affidavits, swine breed papers, any required paperwork from our packer.

## **OHIO STATE FAIR INFORMATION**

### ***\*\*\*Important\*\*\* PQA Requirement Market Swine Exhibitors***

Youth entering a market swine project at the 2020 Ohio State Fair will be required to have a parent/guardian PQA certified in order to meet packer requirements.
