

2021 Advisor Training Dates

All advisors must attend at least one training every year. In addition, every Ohio 4-H Volunteer must complete child abuse and recognition training which will be included as a part of all training dates. Any advisor who does not complete this requirement by April 1 will not be re-enrolled.

With COVID-19 guidelines still in place, we will be giving both in person and virtual options for training this year.

Advisor Training will be conducted in smaller groups again this year. Clubs do not need to have all advisors come on the same date.
