## 2021 PREBLE COUNTY JUNIOR FAIR MARKET BEEF INFORMATION

*Please read carefully!*

Requirements for members wishing to exhibit a market beef (market steer or market heifer) at the 2021 Preble County Junior Fair:

1. Weigh in and Tagging for market beef (market steers and market heifers) will be held on December 5, 2020 from 8-10 a.m. on the Preble County Fairgrounds. Weigh in and Tagging is **MANDATORY FOR ALL MARKET BEEF** being shown at the 2021 Preble County Junior Fair. All paperwork will be collected at the weigh in.
2. All market beef will be tagged with a PCJF tag and a DNA sample will be taken at the time of tagging. EID tags will be provided for those showing in BEST shows and at the Ohio State Fair. At the time of tagging, exhibitors will purchase tags (1 per animal being tagged) for \$4. Please come prepared to pay at the time of tagging. Tag fees will no longer be taken out of the Junior Fair sale check.
3. Each participant may exhibit a maximum of two market beef animals at the Preble County Fair. Participants may sell 1 market beef animal for a premium bid through the Junior Fair livestock sale. Junior Fair participants may enroll a maximum of four market beef animals but can only bring two market beef animals to the Preble County Fair. This includes dairy steers. The two selected animals must be indicated on the Jr. Fair Entry when submitted.
4. All market beef exhibitors must be properly enrolled by the county deadlines. "Properly enrolled" includes
  - a. Bring market beef animal to county weigh in and tagging in December – **mandatory for all market beef**
  - b. Complete 4-H club enrollment by April 1, 2021 or be enrolled in FFA
  - c. Complete your club's/chapter's membership and appropriate project requirements.
5. The overall Grand and Reserve Champion market beef animals must be sold at the Sale of Champions. These animals will be loaded directly onto a trailer for immediate transport to a designated harvest house. The animals will be harvested that day and carcass inspection and processing will proceed according to ODA and USDA procedures.
6. All Junior Fair market beef animals must be born after January 1, 2020.

### **MARKET ANIMAL TAGGING FORM: *Please complete the Market Animal Tagging Form and bring to weigh in.***

We will have blank forms at weigh in but completing ahead of time helps to speed the process along that morning.

**2021 Ohio State Fair** - All market beef animals entered in the 2021 Ohio State Fair Junior Market Beef show must have an electronic identification (EID) ear tag that has a unique 15-digit number and a DNA sample. DNA packets may be picked up at an exhibitor's local Ohio State University Extension Office or at any Ohio Cattlemen's Association (OCA) BEST sanctioned show prior to the January 15 deadline. Any market beef animal that is expected to be shown at the Ohio State Fair that has a pre-existing EID tag, such as an RFID tag, will not need to have an additional EID tag placed in the animal's ear for State Fair purposes. The animal's existing 15-digit identification number will also serve as the animal's Ohio State Fair identification number. Exhibitors of animals not shown at an OCA BEST sanctioned show should contact their County Extension Office for an EID tag.
