## PRE-FAIR JUDGING INFORMATION:

Participants should bring to judging:

1. Completed project book
2. Pattern or instructions for item constructed
3. Complete total look outfit to fulfil requirements of project
4. Information to complete narration for Fair Style Revue

Participants will be judged on:

1. Mastery of project book
2. Garment constructed - in projects requiring this

Before judging participants should also:

1. Review project book information
2. Make sure all extra threads are snipped off on constructed garments
3. Know the type of fabric or materials used in your garment
4. Know the basic steps followed to complete your outfit
5. Be able to discuss any problems you encountered – it is okay if you struggle with a step or have to tear out a seam multiple times. Your project is a learning experience. Do not be afraid to tell the judge what you learned along the way.
6. Practice standing, sitting and walking in your completed outfit before ironing it for judging
7. Iron your outfit thoroughly. Dressing rooms are available, so that you can change into your outfit when you arrive. This will help to keep your garment from becoming wrinkled or stained.
8. Take care of your grooming – be sure to have clean and neat hair and nails
9. Pay attention to the foundation garments you wear

**PLEASE NOTE:** Ohio Clothing guidelines require 4-H'ers who take more than one clothing project to complete separate learning experiences related to each, including creating a separate, complete, total-look outfit FOR EACH PROJECT. (e.g. a top made for one project cannot be used in another project).

State Fair participants will be selected at Pre-Fair Judging. ***Any member selected for Ohio State Fair participation will need to pick up a State Fair packet either at judging or at the Extension Office prior to attending the Ohio State Fair.***

Participants will be judged in the order listed on the schedules. Times are approximate. Be prepared to wait.
