#### **CLOTHING, FOOD AND NUTRITION, AND SPECIAL INTEREST PROJECT JUDGING**

**Preble County Fairgrounds Expo Expansion– JULY 19**

Pre-Fair Clothing Judging, Pre-Fair Food and Nutrition Judging, and Special Interest Judging will be held on Wednesday, July 19 at the Expo Expansion.

Participants will meet with judges who will evaluate the member's project book. Grades will be given at Pre-Fair judging for Clothing and Special Interest projects. Food and Nutrition grades are given at the Food Show. Representatives for the Ohio State Fair are selected at Pre-Fair Judging.

#### **LIVESTOCK PROJECT BOOKS EVALUATION OPPORTUNITIES**

**Skillathon** – July 14, 15 & 16 – 1PM to 7PM each day - Expo Expansion. There will be people there to evaluate livestock project books. 4-H members can stop by to have their books checked even if they don't participate in Skillathon.

**Special Interest Project Judging** – Wednesday, July 19 - 3PM to 7PM – Expo Expansion. 4-H members can bring along their livestock project books to be evaluated that day.

**Livestock Project Book Evaluation Day** – Thursday, July 20 – 1PM to 7PM – Expo Expansion.

**Pre-registration/appointments are not necessary for 2023 Livestock Project Book Evaluation.**

A reminder that members MUST complete a livestock book evaluation to be eligible to compete as a 4-H member at the Preble County Fair.

Project Books should have been purchased through the Extension Office. For those members in the 2nd year of a project or beyond our livestock supplement can be found on the project completion page at preble.osu.edu.
