**QUALIFICATIONS:**

1. Each candidate must be a member of a 4-H Club, FCCLA, or FFA Chapter, Camp Fire Boys and Girls Club or Girl Scout Troop and be enrolled in the project of interest, i.e. beef project to run for Beef Queen.
2. Candidates for Livestock/Non-Livestock Queen/King can also run for Junior Fair King and Queen Court as well, but will only be chosen for one. If running for King and Queen Court, candidate only permitted to run for 1 Livestock/Non-Livestock
3. Can only represent one species as queen in any one year.
4. Each contestant may not be married, not have been married, or not have borne a child.
5. Livestock/Non-Livestock Queen/King will be given a list of activities in which she/he **will be required to participate** throughout the fair as well as other county fairs and community events. **If you will be unable to attend the fair to carry out duties and responsibilities, please reconsider your participation in this contest.** (The only exception to this rule will be participation in The Ohio State Fair and prior notification to the King & Queen Advisory Committee will be required.) Queen/King will be required to attend organizational meeting to assign responsibilities during the 2018 Preble County Junior Fair.
6. All applicants for Preble County Junior Fair Livestock/Non-Livestock Queen/King must complete an application and essay, and submit them by the deadline. All applicants must also make available the Advisor Evaluation to their advisor and the advisor must submit by the deadline. All applicants **MUST BE PRESENT** for the personal interview with the panel of judges. **No phone interviews or videoed interviews will be permitted if you are not able to attend the Personal Interview and the Evening event you are not eligible to participate in the 2019 Royalty Contest.** The judges' decisions are final.
7. Return this form to the Preble County Extension Office, Eaton, OH 45320 by **May 1, 2019**. Contestants must also submit their, activities resume, essay and picture with their form, Advisor Evaluations shall be submitted separately, but by the May 1, 2019 deadline. An interview schedule will be sent at a later date.

**JUDGING:**

1. Contestants will submit an activities resume and essay.
2. Contestants will have advisor complete and submit evaluation form.
3. Contestants will be interviewed by a panel of judges on Saturday, June 15, 2019 at Preble Shawnee High School, interview time TBD at later date.
4. Business Casual dress (no jeans) will be acceptable for the interview. Formal dress is suggested for the evening program at 7:00 p.m. June 15, 2019 at Preble Shawnee High School.
5. The Livestock Royalty will be selected and crowned the same evening as the contest. The Royalty is expected to maintain the dress and poise of the position during the entire time of the fair and all other community, county or state activities.
