MARKET BEEF WEIGH-IN—IMPORTANT—ACTION NEEDED BEFORE WEIGH IN

The date for Market Beef weigh in is December 4 from 8 a.m. — 10 a.m.

We were excited last week to get the wand we are going to use to scan tags at the weigh in on Saturday. So market beef are going to be the test for using this new technology. Because we are going to use this technology on Saturday, we need you to do a couple things prior to weigh in.

DO THIS BEFORE WEIGH IN

1. Complete your 4-H enrollment in 4honline if you are taking your project through 4-H. Be sure to add your market beef project and any other projects you plan to take in 2022. If you need to add other projects before the April 1 enrollment deadline, we will help you do that. [Complete your enrollment by 11:59 p.m. Thursday, December 2.](#) Doing this ahead of time will avoid extra time for you on Saturday.
2. Add all of your market beef animals to your 4honline profile **by 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, December 2.** You can find instructions posted on our website but it is simple to follow the steps once you click on the animal tab in your profile.
3. Print and complete the tagging form found on our website and bring to weigh in. You can find it at: <https://preble.osu.edu/program-areas/4-h-youth-development/preble-county-fair>.

ON SATURDAY

1. Bring your completed tag in form
2. Bring money for tags
3. Be patient with us as we try out this new process. Look for specific instructions on Saturday that may be different than in the past.
