POULTRY CHECK IN AND POLLURUM TESTING

All Fancy Poultry are required to come to check in days. Mark your Calendar...

Fancy Poultry Check-In & Pullorum Blood Testing Friday, June 23, 2023 - 7PM to 9PM at the Expo Center

To save on wait time in the Pullorum Blood Testing line, 4-H Clubs or FFA Chapters can schedule their GROUP to get the Pullorum Blood Testing portion of the check-in done on another date and/or time. This option is being offered on a group basis, not as individual appointments. To schedule your 4-H Club/FFA Chapter to get the Pullorum Blood Testing done at an alternate time please contact Kami Schooley at 937-414-9428. **Please note that this option **does not** exempt you from attending the Fancy Poultry Breed check -in on June 23, 2023.**

Pullorum testing: All land fowl coming to the fair needs to be tested with the exception of birds under one year that have hatchery papers. Waterfowl do not need to be tested. The fee for testing is typically \$1 per bird. Turkeys must be tested by a veterinarian. Plan ahead to be sure that you have the results back from your turkey.
