

## Project Pin and Special Award Categories

### **Special Awards**

**Achievement** – This award will recognize members who have high achievements in the 4-H Program. These are the members who go above and beyond with project work or service to the 4-H program. Project work should show variety and/ or growth over time. It should be clear how a member’s skills have improved when taking the same project for several years. This should be reflected in a member’s pink sheet.

**Leadership** – This award will recognize members who have used their 4-H leadership skills either significantly at the club level or beyond the community club. Emphasis will be given to 4-H Leadership but other community leadership activities will be considered. Significant leadership at the club level is defined as contributing to the club in ways more than just holding an office. This could be by organizing activities, serving on committees, or mentoring other 4-Hers. Office held will also be taken in to consideration.

**Personal Development** – Those recognized for this award are nominated by club advisors. Nominees will be recognized for growth observed through participation in the 4-H Program and 4-H Project work. This award is not necessarily for the person who wins first place. It is meant to share the achievements of those who find personal growth through participation in 4-H. It might be a member who overcomes an obstacle, who perseveres, who shows outstanding effort, or other examples of growth.

**Citizenship** – 4-H Citizenship is the knowledge, skills, attitudes and motivation that give youth the capacity to move beyond ones individual self-interest and to be committed to the well-being of some larger group. (<http://4h.ucanr.edu/Projects/Citizenship/>) This award will recognize members who contribute to their community through one of three citizenship focus areas: Civic Engagement, Civic Education, or Service.
